## SERVING CHILDREN, ADULTS, AND FAMILIES IN WARREN, SARATOGA, AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES

Northern Rivers Family of Services has served the children, adults, and families of New York state since 1829 with a continuum of home-, clinic-, school-, and community-based, vocational rehabilitative, supported employment, and senior-supporting programs that provide person-centered, trauma-informed innovative solutions to ensure clients live their best lives.

Today Northern Rivers has more than 100 employees throughout the Warren–Washington–Saratoga area, serving more than 2,000 people each year.

Behavioral Health services include:

- the Behavioral Health Center in Malta is a NYS Office of Mental Health–licensed outpatient counseling facility serving the public
- Unlimited Potential offers vocational rehabilitation and supported employment services for adults in recovery from psychiatric challenges
- School-Based Behavioral Health offices, with 13 offices serving 9 districts, provides NYS Office of Mental Health–licensed outpatient counseling to students in the school building
- Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) provides rehabilitation and support services for residents of Warren and Washington counties who struggle with serious and persistent mental illness
- Home-Based Crisis Intervention provides intensive in-home services for families with children, help them to manage crises, build family relationships, and build life and coping skills

Community-based services include:

- Prevention and family preservation, intensive programs designed to provide in-home support to keep children safely at home with families
- Health Home Care Management, for children and adults, service coordination and support for those enrolled in a NYS Medicaid Health Home
- Child and Family Treatment and Support Services (CFTSS), provide home and community-based rehabilitative, therapeutic, and peer-driven supports

Foster care, comprehensive support for foster children, foster parents, and biological family to work toward reunification and permanency goals.

Residential and education programs in Albany and Schenectady provide services to clients in Warren, Washington, and Saratoga counties.
