# **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE TRAINING FOR CHILD WELFARE WORKERS**

## **TWO-DAY TRAINING PRESENTED AT SATRI**

Presented by the staff of the Sidney Albert Training & Research Institute

### **Description**

This skills-based two-day training was developed to assist child welfare workers with families where domestic violence and child abuse and maltreatment overlap. This training provides a comprehensive overview of adult domestic violence, the role of the child welfare worker in domestic violence cases, and the impact of domestic abuse on the safety of the nonoffending parent (NOP) and children. Participants will have the opportunity to assess for and respond to domestic violence, discuss safety planning with the protective parent, evaluate the effectiveness of various interventions, and review legal remedies.

Day 1: Historical Perspective: The Nature of Abuse Domestic Violence and Children Mitigating Factors In Her Shoes: An Interactive Simulation

Day 2: Steps to Intervention Safety Planning Assailant Interviews Planning for Intervention Summary and Evaluation

**Note: Participants must attend both days**

**Who should attend:** This training is designed for child welfare caseworkers and supervisors in the Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) and Departments of Social Services (DSS), funded foster care, preventive care, and voluntary agencies.

This training is not for Child Protective Services (CPS) or Administration for Children Services (ACS) workers, and it does not satisfy the requirement for CPS workers mandated domestic violence training.

# Compliance Training

Every member of our Workforce, full- or part-time, is required to complete several mandated compliance trainings during the month of January in order to remain on active duty. Our Learning Management System (LMS) software, available at <https://northernrivers.csod.com/>, was designed to facilitate this process. **All Workforce members with regular computer access are expected to complete these trainings online.** We will offer a limited number of in-person trainings **only** for those without regular computer access. Below are some guidelines on accessing these trainings:

Please use your six digit employee id as your log in to the LMS. The HR Fair Treatment Practices Policy is only available on line. All employees must take this training on line.

1. The online versions of the trainings will automatically be available to all users on their LMS training portal home page **beginning January 1**. Please do not request access to them, or they will appear multiple times in your account.
2. Log in and complete the trainings **between January 1 and 31**—if you attempt to complete the trainings before January 1, they will not count.
3. The traditional classroom trainings (listed below) require pre-registration. These are listed in the LMS as “January Compliance Month Trainings”.
